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Conversations with My Daughter Dad, when did God Die?

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T: Dad, when did God die?

Dad: "God" is immortal.

T: What is Immortal?

Dad: I see!

T: When did he die, daddy?

Dad: Do you remember I said God means different things in different religions?

T: No.

Dad: Do you remember I said ancient people believed in many Gods?

T: Yes.

Dad: Do you remember I said that Greeks and Romans made big and beautiful temples for their Gods and Goddesses?

T: Like Athena?

Dad: That's right, honey; Goddesses like Athena, Hera, and Artemis. Now, remember the story about Moses?

T: "Prince of Egypt" daddy? *(Refers to Disney animated film)*

Dad: Yes, "Prince of Egypt"; do you remember what God meant to the ancient Egyptians? Now think what God meant to Moses and his people.

T: What was Moses' mothers' name?

Dad: Jochebed (Yo-shi-Beth). What I mean is that God meant and means different things to different people.

T: Was it before the Ice Age?

Dad: No, about four thousand years after the Ice age ended. You know Ice Age started about 70 thousand years ago and ended about 10 thousand years ago.

T: I know that.

Dad: How do you know that?

T: From Jack and Annie books. *(Refers to a characters from Magic Tree House book collections)*

Dad: Good.

T: Was it after the Dinosaurs?

Dad: Oh yeh! Dinosaurs lived some 60 million years ago – it means thousands and thousands of years ago.

T: Dad, Mammoths and Saber-toothed cats lived in Ice Ages.

Dad: I know. What was I saying?

T: Dad Is Jesus dead?

Dad: Oh, I was saying that God means different things in different religions. And Judaism and Islam think similarly about God, the living and the dead. But Christians think differently about God, the living and the dead. So, if you are a Christian Jesus was resurrected – returned to life.

T: Which we know cannot happen.

Dad: If you are a Christian, then, there is no question, no doubt. And, also, if you are a Christian, there is Heaven too. Of course, Islam believes in Heaven... It's a little complicated - you know.

T: I'm confused. Dad, did Jesus die?

Dad: It's Christmas sweetie. Let's talk about his birth. We can talk about his resurrection later.

Dad: January 6th.
